

Dear *Munni Sahib*,

To give ST candidates a better chance to succeed in competitive examinations, the Department of Tribal Affairs has devised a scheme for coaching for disadvantaged ST candidates in quality coaching institutions to enable them to appear in competitive examinations and succeed in obtaining an appropriate job in the Central / State services. The guidelines include implementation of the scheme and courses to be covered, eligibility of the coaching institution, eligibility of the candidates, income criteria, selection of proposals, funding pattern/release of grants, procedure for submitting the application, monitoring and review of performance and terms & conditions etc. The State Govt. has decided to support such activities for local J&K ST students to improve their representation in All India and State Services

The highlights of the programme (IAS coaching) are as under:-

- Free coaching for specified duration in the reputed institutions for duration of 4-6 months in Civil Services(Prelim)/State Civil Services (Prelim) & Civil Services (Mains)/State Civil Services (Mains) :
- coaching fees to institution per candidate= Rs.100,000/-
- Grant for books = Rs. 15000/-
- The subsidiary allowance for boarding/lodging shall be provided for a maximum period of 03 months @ Rs. 5000/- per month outside the state and Rs. 3000/- per month inside the state.

- Forms to be submitted in the office of Deputy Director, Employment in respective districts or directly to Distt. Dev. Commissioners.
- For selection of meritorious candidates, District Level Screening Committee headed by Deputy Commissioner of the District with Deputy Director, Employment as Member Secretary & Principal Govt. Degree College & Warden, Tribal Hostel as Members.
- 30% seats shall be reserved for female ST students and 5% for physically challenged ST students.
- The District Level Screening Committee shall shortlist the eligible candidates on following criteria:-
  1. Civil Services (Prelim)/State Civil Services (Prelim) - Based on the score of Graduation Degree
  2. Civil Services (Mains)/State Civil Services (Mains) - Based on the score in Graduation Degree.
  3. Candidates who have qualified the Preliminary Exam of State/Central Civil Services subject to proof of Result.

It is requested to send the list of eligible candidates to Administrative Department by or before 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2016.
